

**COVID-19 Update**  
**April 16, 2020**

## **Attention all RN's**

Long-Term Care workers, including Retirement Home workers, will no longer be allowed to work in more than one home or other health service provider (e.g. hospital) to limit the spread of COVID-19. This direction is contained in a new Order from the government released on April 14.

As a result of this Order, Long-Term Care and Retirement Home workers who must temporarily give up a job in another care setting are protected from losing their job as they are entitled to an unpaid Emergency Leave of Absence. This means that at the conclusion of the COVID emergency an employee will be able to return to their other employer(s).

Local 100 members who work in Long-Term Care and /or a Retirement Home and for another Health Care Employer must comply with the expectation to disclose their preferred work location to the LTC/Retirement home employer no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 17, 2020. Please ensure that your Retirement Home members comply with the expectation to disclose their preferred work location to the Employer no later than 9 am on April 20, 2020.
