Hello All,

Wishing you all a warm welcome into the New Year. Your ONA Local would like to start this year with an improved communication strategy for our members. Through email and phone correspondence, and in person discussions with our members it was highlighted that we need to do better in updating everyone on local issues and general communication. Your Local 100 executive have a goal of keeping you better informed through personal emails, and social media updates.

The Have Your Say Survey (now closed) is currently being reviewed by our Negotiations Committee. The items that pertain to local issues will be flagged for discussion and language review. Some of the local issues identified include scheduling, holiday waiver period, use of stat days, vacation requests, management rights and committee representation. The Negotiations Committee will continue to meet regularly to prepare for contract negotiations which are quickly approaching.

Local 100 remains in administration with ONA Central providing support. Angie Stott continues to represent our local as the interim Bargaining Unit President. She can be reached at LHSCRNBUP@ona.org.

Your Site Reps have also committed to regular visits at all LHSC locations. This initiative started on Monday January 9th with a visit to UH and will continue weekly. Please keep an eye out for us! One of the top themes from the units that we have visited is concerns related to reassignment. Other topics include schedules, flexibility of shifts and safe staffing levels. As your ONA representatives and fellow nurses, we take these issues very seriously. We understand personally the significant impact that these problems have, they impact work-life balance, and our members physical and emotional health. We will continue to advocate on your behalf in the meetings we attend with the employer and the various committees that our local executives and ward reps sit on.

We are always looking for our RN membership to be involved in the Local. We recognize that nurses and health professionals are tired, and that the culture in health care is at an all-time low, but we need your help and support to change this! ONA has come upcoming opportunities and we would love you to join.

ONA clothing/gear and picket signs will be provided to help draw attention to our cause!
